Pool Access:

- Homeowners must be in good standing with HOA dues to have access to the amenities.
- Please see the pool schedule on the next page.
- To gain access to the pool, residents will need their key fob and a wristband for each swimmer.

Pool Fob & Wristbands:

- We will continue to use the red wristbands from last year. Each homeowner will/should have 1 wristband per member of their family.
- Each homeowner will/should have 1 key fob per household. Replacement or additional key fobs are \$25.00.
- New residents may obtain their key fob from the clubhouse at the following times/locations:

General Bright Water Pool Rules

SWIM DIAPERS - Parents of young swimmers are reminded that infants and toddlers still in diapers MUST wear either a "swim diaper" or plastic pants with elastic around the waist and legs.

POOL DECK/MAIN POOL RULES

- The pool facility is only open during lifeguard hours of 11 am to 9 pm.
- During SAYOR hours, anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Security cameras are in place at the pool facility.
- Lifeguard on duty is in charge of the pool and is required to enforce rules
- No running anywhere on the pool deck
- No Glass containers in the pool area. (permitted on upper deck)
- No sitting or standing on the shoulders of another swimmer
- No game or activity, deemed dangerous by the lifeguard or that inhibits others to swim
- In the case of extended extreme weather after 7:00 pm, the pool will be closed for the safety of the lifeguards and swimmers
- No profanity, improper behavior or remarks
- No personally owned music without earphones
- No pets, bicycles, skateboards, scooters or roller blades inside the pool area
- No one intoxicated or under the influence of drugs allowed in the pool area
- Smoking is not permitted in the pool area or clubhouse.
- Swimmers breaking the pool rules will be given a warning by the lifeguard. If the problem persists after the initial warning, the swimmer(s) will sit out next to the lifeguard for a designated period of time given by the lifeguard. If there are any more problems after time out, the swimmer(s) will be sent home with notification to their parents and/or Property Manager. Swimmer(s) sent home will have their actions documented. Persistent behavior problems will result in rescinding of pool access for time to be determined by HOA board
- No one other than the Property manager or Pool Chair should suggest, complain or reprimand the lifeguards while on duty. All problems, suggestions or questions with pool management must be brought to the Property Manager or Pool Chair's attention.
- Wear appropriate swim attire. No cut-offs or street clothes with buckles, rivets or sharp objects permitted
- No persons with communicable or infectious diseases, rashes or sores may use the pool

SLIDE POOL RULES

- Only one swimmer may go down the slide at a time
- Swimmer must sit facing forward the entire trip down the slide
- Swimmers must exit the slide pool immediately after exiting the slide
- No diving from the slide
- No blocking the water flow on the slide
- Leave the landing pool promptly after exiting the slide
- Wait until the previous slider leaves the exit area before starting
